Orange County Planning Commission Unanimously Supports SEIR

OC Dana Point Harbor presented the Subsequent Environmental Impact Report (SEIR) for the waterside improvement project to the Orange County Planning Commission on September 26, 2012. We are pleased to have received unanimous support from the Commission to proceed in presenting this to the Board of Supervisors with a recommendation to certify the SEIR.

The SEIR is a necessary step in the construction of new slips and gangways, which is one of the elements of the Dana Point Harbor Revitalization. Once the SEIR is certified by the Board of Supervisors, the County will proceed with preparing specific designs of the slips to be included in the Coastal Development Permit (CDP) application. This CDP application will ultimately be presented to the California Coastal Commission who retains authority over any waterside project.

OC Dana Point Harbor is pleased with this approval continuing to make progress on the Dana Point Revitalization Plan, and thanks the Commission for their support as well as the community members who attended the public hearing to speak on the item.
