Vessels Should Exercise Caution

OC Dana Point Harbor is planning the next underwater clean-up event with volunteer scuba divers on Saturday, May 11th from 8 AM to 12 Noon, in the West Basin Marina on the cove side at A-Dock.

Boaters are asked to exercise care and caution when operating vessels near the dive area.

We are requesting boaters located on West Basin A-Dock not operate their vessels during this four hour event due to diver safety. If you must move your vessel during this four hour period, please contact the Dana West Marina at (949)493-6222 for assistance.

Floats with dive flags will be located at the inner-channel end of each of the affected fairways. County and Marina staff as well as Volunteers will be present to assist and protect the divers as they conduct their underwater searches.

This Underwater Cleanup effort is part of OC Dana Point Harbor's continuing water quality improvement program; the semi-annual event will continue to move throughout the east and west marina basins on a multi-year cycle.
